### Simple past

<b>I</b>	clucked

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have clucked
<b>you</b>	have clucked
<b>he/she/it</b>	has clucked

### Past perfect

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am clucking
<b>you</b>	are clucking
<b>he/she/it</b>	is clucking
<b>we</b>	are clucking
<b>you</b>	are clucking
<b>they</b>	are clucking

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was clucking
<b>you</b>	were clucking
<b>he/she/it</b>	was clucking
<b>we</b>	were clucking
<b>you</b>	were clucking
<b>they</b>	were clucking

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been clucking
<b>you</b>	have been clucking
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been clucking
<b>we</b>	have been clucking
<b>you</b>	have been clucking
<b>they</b>	have been clucking

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been clucking
<b>you</b>	had been clucking
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been clucking

### Future continuous
