<b>I</b>	lie
<b>you</b>	lie
<b>he/she/it</b>	lies
<b>we</b>	lie
<b>you</b>	lie
<b>they</b>	lie

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	lay; lied
<b>you</b>	lay; lied
<b>he/she/it</b>	lay; lied
<b>we</b>	lay; lied
<b>you</b>	lay; lied
<b>they</b>	lay; lied

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have lain; lied
<b>you</b>	have lain; lied
<b>he/she/it</b>	has lain; lied
<b>we</b>	have lain; lied
<b>you</b>	have lain; lied
<b>they</b>	have lain; lied

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had lain; lied
<b>you</b>	had lain; lied
<b>he/she/it</b>	had lain; lied
<b>we</b>	had lain; lied
<b>you</b>	had lain; lied
<b>they</b>	had lain; lied

### Future

<b>I</b>	will lie
<b>you</b>	will lie
<b>he/she/it</b>	will lie
<b>we</b>	will lie
<b>you</b>	will lie
<b>they</b>	will lie

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have lain; lied
<b>you</b>	will have lain; lied
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have lain; lied
<b>we</b>	will have lain; lied
<b>you</b>	will have lain; lied
<b>they</b>	will have lain; lied

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am lying
<b>you</b>	are lying
<b>he/she/it</b>	is lying
<b>we</b>	are lying
<b>you</b>	are lying
<b>they</b>	are lying

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was lying
<b>you</b>	were lying
<b>he/she/it</b>	was lying
<b>we</b>	were lying
<b>you</b>	were lying
<b>they</b>	were lying

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been lying
<b>you</b>	have been lying
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been lying
<b>we</b>	have been lying
<b>you</b>	have been lying
<b>they</b>	have been lying

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been lying
<b>you</b>	had been lying
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been lying
<b>we</b>	had been lying
<b>you</b>	had been lying
<b>they</b>	had been lying

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be lying
<b>you</b>	will be lying
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be lying
<b>we</b>	will be lying
