<b>I</b>	tie
<b>you</b>	tie
<b>he/she/it</b>	ties
<b>we</b>	tie

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	tied
<b>you</b>	tied
<b>he/she/it</b>	tied
<b>we</b>	tied
<b>you</b>	tied
<b>they</b>	tied

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have tied
<b>you</b>	have tied
<b>he/she/it</b>	has tied
<b>we</b>	have tied
<b>you</b>	have tied
<b>they</b>	have tied

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had tied

### Future

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am tying
<b>you</b>	are tying
<b>he/she/it</b>	is tying
<b>we</b>	are tying
<b>you</b>	are tying
<b>they</b>	are tying

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was tying
<b>you</b>	were tying
<b>he/she/it</b>	was tying
<b>we</b>	were tying
<b>you</b>	were tying
<b>they</b>	were tying

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been tying
<b>you</b>	have been tying
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been tying
<b>we</b>	have been tying
<b>you</b>	have been tying
<b>they</b>	have been tying

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been tying
<b>you</b>	had been tying
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been tying
<b>we</b>	had been tying

### Future continuous
