Mag ik erbij komen?

May I buy you something to drink?

Asking if you may treat the person to a drink

Kan ik je iets te drinken aanbieden?

Do you come here often?

Small talk

Kom je hier vaak?

So, what do you do for a living?

Small talk

En, wat doe je voor werk?

Do you want to dance?

Asking someone to dance with you

Wil je dansen?

Would you like to get some fresh air?

Asking a person if he/she wants to go outside with you

Wil je wat frisse lucht halen?

Do you want to go to a different party?

Asking a person to come with you to another location

Wil je naar een ander feest gaan?

Let's get out of here!

Asking a person to leave with you and go somewhere else

Laten we hier weggaan!

My place or yours?

Asking a person where you will spend the night together

Naar mij of naar jou?

Would you like to watch a movie at my place?

Inviting a person to see a movie at your home

Wil je samen bij mij een film kijken?

Do you have any plans for tonight?

Asking for a date indirectly

Heb je plannen voor vanavond?

Would you like to have lunch/dinner with me sometime?

Dankjewel voor een geweldige avond! Wel thuis!

You're funny!

Complimenting someone on their humour

Je bent grappig!

You have beautiful eyes!

Complimenting someone on their eyes

Je hebt prachtige ogen!

You're a great dancer!

Complimenting someone on their dancing skills

Je kunt goed dansen!

You look beautiful in that dress/shirt!

Complimenting someone on their fashion sense/figure

Je ziet er goed uit in die jurk/dat shirt!

I have been thinking about you all day!

Showing that you like the person a lot

Ik heb de hele dag aan je gedacht!

It's been really nice talking to you!

Leave me alone.

Straightforward way of declining

Laat me met rust.

Get lost!

Rude way of declining

Rot op!

Don't touch me!

Raak me niet aan!

Get your hands off me!

Saying no when the other person is touching you with his/her hands

Laat je handen thuis!
